**Communication Project Officer** for the EU funded Project 'Restoring effective management control in the Kidepo Game Reserve and associated catchment forests in South Sudan and improving the welfare of neighbouring communities.

## **Background**

Enjojo Foundation is a non-profit organisation incorporated on 14/12/2020 under the NGO Act 2016 of the Republic of South Sudan. Enjojo Foundation's Mission is to manage and conserve protected areas through a conservation model which fosters peace, supports sustainable community livelihoods and enterprises, and enables socio-political stability.

Enjojo Foundation is working under a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Ministry of Wildlife Conservation and Tourism in South Sudan (MWCT) for the co-management of Lantoto National Park and Kidepo Game Reserve. In collaboration with the South Sudan Wildlife Service, EF takes on responsibility for all aspects of park management including Promoting Peace and good Governance, Community development, Park Protection, Infrastructure and logistics, Wildlife and Habitat management, and Tourism Development. The Kidepo Game Reserve was established in 1975 with an area of about 280,000 ha (2800 km²) in Eastern Equatoria. It falls under IUCN Management Category VI - a protected area with the sustainable use of natural resources (IUCN, 2022).

We are seeking a talented and enthusiastic Communication Project Officer to join our team for the EU funded project 'Restoring effective management control in the Kidepo Game Reserve and associated catchment forests in South Sudan and improving the welfare of neighbouring communities'.

The ideal candidate will have experience in producing high quality videos, possess strong editing skills, and be able to tell a compelling visual story.

The successful candidate will also have excellent skills to organize logistics for the implementation of the project activities and coordinate with all stakeholders in a challenging environment.

The job is field based with duty station in Ikwoto in Eastern Equatoria State.

## **Key responsibilities:**

#### High-quality video production and communication:

- Capture high-quality video content.
- Plan and set up video shoots, including lighting and audio equipment.
- Edit raw footage into polished, engaging videos.
- Manage video archives and organize footage.
- Handle live streaming for events.
- Contribute to the creation of high-quality content, including press releases, newsletters, and

- Supports the definition and implementation of EF's communication strategy and develops communication channels and materials.
- Manages website and social media presence.
- Ensure that all project materials comply with the donor's branding and visibility guidelines.

### Logistics:

- Organize the logistics for the implementation of the project activities (accommodation, bookings of training venues, transportation, flights etc).
- Coordinate activity plan with members of the project team, stakeholders, and beneficiaries.
- Facilitate flight bookings and coordinate vehicle movement priorities.
- Take part in post-activity evaluation sessions to discuss results and suggest improvements.
- Keep proper administrative records of project expenditures.
